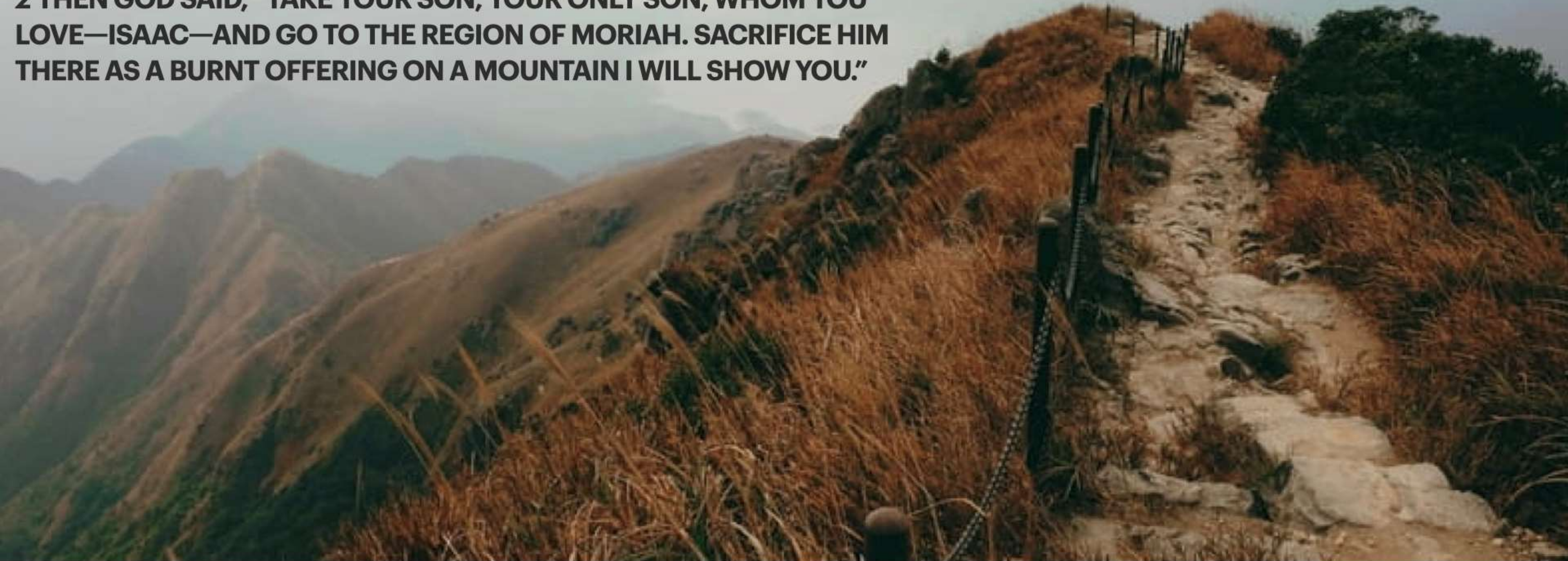
THE LORD WILL PROVIDE
